There was a fantastic vibe throughout the night with much quality networking taking place. Some of the key messages from Bernard Salt included:

- If you are in business now and you are located on the North West side of Melbourne, you are in the best location to capitalise on the growth of Melbourne over the next 20 years. Sunbury is in an ideal position to take advantage on this as it is located right on the edge of both the North and West growth corridors. He did point out that business operators still have to be vigilant and in in the right kind of business and run it well in order to capitalise on the opportunity this will present.
